MINISTERS OF THE EUCHARIST BRINGING HOLY COMMUNION TO THE HOUSEBOUND

Some of our ministers bring Holy Communion to those not able to come to church and at times it may be administering to a family member or neighbour. The Archbishop is concerned about some practices that have arisen and are not appropriate to sacredness of the Holy Eucharist. He has therefore requested in all parishes that the person taking the Blessed Sacrament must present themselves at the Sacristy before Mass and give their Pyx to the Sacristan stating how many hosts they will quire. The Pyx will be left on the Altar and the hosts consecrated at that Mass. The Pvx with the sacred host can be collected at the end of the Mass.

Should a minister discover on calling to a house the person is not there/gone to hospital the spare host should be consumed by the minister or returned to the tabernacle in the church. On no account should the Eucharist be kept at home overnight.

From now on a minister must not present with a Pyx in the Holy Communion line at Mass as this puts the Priest or the minister distributing the communion in a difficult position. The parish must keep a register of people who are receiving Holy Communion in the home, even if only temporary. We would be grateful for complying with the Archbishop's directive as it is in the interest of the sacredness of the Holy Eucharist.

"GOD REACHES OUT TO US AND REACHES OUT TO US IN MYSTERY."

When speaking to a group of pilgrims in Rome recently, Pope Francis made the following remarks:

"Many people think that today it is more difficult to say we are Christians and to live faith in Christ."

This reminded me of a biography of St Anthony where the writer said that there was never a so-called golden age for Christianity and that each century brings its own challenges for the Church and people of faith. Nonetheless, there is a great residue of faith in our parish, in our community and throughout our Archdiocese.

I saw this faith again at first hand last Saturday at the Archdiocese of Dublin pilgrimage to Knock which was attended by many pilgrims from our parish Partnership and many others from throughout the Archdiocese.

Attendance at the final mass in the basilica was estimated at well over 3,000 where Archbishop Dermot Farrell said: "The apparition of Mary, St Joseph, and St John here in Knock is a call to acknowledge and welcome the silent faithful presence of the Lord in the very depth of our lives. Our God reaches out to us and reaches out to us in mystery. What happened here [at Knock] is a profound outreach to God's people."

There are further plans to develop the Shrine as we approach the 150th anniversary of the apparition in five years' time in 2029. There is a new creation walk developed by Father Brian Grogan S.J. which will be launched shortly and new Knock Youth Village for young people travelling to Knock. The Archbishop added: "This is a profound witness to the reality of the Church: To come on pilgrimage to Knock together, is to proclaim that the Church happens when we are together".
